ANGEL ISLAND CAMP: 6/17-8/16

Located on Angel Island State Park, Angel Island Camp has been operating since 1973. Angel Island Camp offers a traditional day camp experience for children ages 6 to 13. Each day campers and staff take the ferry from Tiburon and San Francisco to Angel Island to participate in camp activities such as crafts, games, beach activities, kayaking, fishing, etc. Our oldest campers participate in bi-weekly overnights on the island and take field trips to theme parks.

CAMPUS KIDS: 7/22-8/9

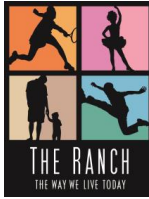

THE RANCH SUMMER CAMPS JOB DESCRIPTIONS

Tiburon Camp Director-Art & Garden Camp/Campus Kids (\$22- 28 per hour)

Under the supervision of the Youth Recreation Supervisor, the Camp Director will plan, purchase, develop, implement and lead all camp activities/programs. In addition, Camp Director will supervise 2-3 staff members and volunteers and be the main point of contact with parents.

San Francisco Site Coordinator– Fantastical Adventures or Angel Island Camp (\$23-\$28 per hour)

Under the supervision of the Camp Director, the SF Coordinator plans, organizes and implements the day camp curriculum and is responsible for overseeing the safety of the campers and ensuring there is adequate supervision of the campers and activities at all times. The Head Counselor/San Francisco Site Coordinator is the liaison to our families and campers taking the ferry from San Francisco. They are responsible for morning check-in, ferry tickets, and SF parent communication. Must be at least 21 years old, have a minimum of 1 year experience in a youth program, and possess strong communication skills.

San Francisco or Tiburon Head Counselor - Angel Island Camp (\$23-\$27 per hour)

The Head Counselor is an experienced counselor that supervises the campers and staff in their assigned age group. Head Counselors plan and implement age appropriate activities and assist the Camp Director in creating and leading activities for theme/challenge days. The Head Counselor is the point of contact for the campers' parents during daily check-in and check-out. Must be at least 21 years old, have a minimum of 1 year experience in a camp program, and possess strong communication skills.

San Francisco or Tiburon Counselors- All Camps (\$19-\$23 per hour)

Counselors are responsible for the direct supervision and guidance of 8-12 campers. Responsibilities include setting up/cleaning up and leading camp activities, ensuring camper safety, managing group during transition periods, and the general well-being of campers in their care. Counselors may specialize in specific program areas such as crafts, games, sports, etc. Must be at least 18 years old, be creative, energetic, and enthusiastic about working with children. Experience preferred, but not necessary.

San Francisco or Tiburon Junior Counselors- All Camps (\$16-\$19 per hour)

Junior Counselors assist Counselors and Head Counselors with the supervision, care, and guidance of campers within their assigned group. Must be at least 16 years old and obtain a work permit, be creative, energetic, and enthusiastic about working with children. No experience necessary.
